On Tuesday, March 21, at 3:00 p.m., the Sioux County Sheriff's Office posted a notice on its Facebook page seeking the help of the public in locating Peter Baccam, age 22, of Sioux Center, IA.

Baccam was wanted by the Sheriff's Office for failing to appear for a jail sentence where he was required to turn himself in to the Sioux County Jail on Monday, March 13. Baccam was then to be transported to the Iowa Department of Corrections in Oakdale to serve a two year prison sentence for a conviction of domestic assault causing bodily injury. Baccam's whereabouts remained unknown as he avoided apprehension from law enforcement.

Following the post on Facebook, an anonymous person told a Sioux County Deputy Sheriff that they believed Baccam was staying at a residence in Sioux Center. The deputy relayed the tip information to the Sioux Center Police Department who located Baccam at the residence reported by the tipster.

Upon further investigation it was discovered by the Sioux Center Police Officer that Baccam was in violation of a Court ordered protective order as he was in the company at the residence of a person listed on the protection order as a protected party.

On Tuesday, March 21, at 5:16 p.m., Baccam was arrested on the outstanding arrest warrant for failing to appear and a new charge of violating a Court ordered protection order.
