On Sunday, June 4, at 8:28 p.m., the Sioux County Sheriff's Office investigated a motor vehicle accident that occurred at the intersection of Garfield Avenue and 390th Street, three miles west of Sioux Center, IA.

Brooklyn Iverson, age 18, of Rock Valley, IA was driving a 2014 Ford Fusion eastbound on 390th Street. Emiliano Trujillo, age 29, of Rock Valley was driving a 2006 Jeep Grand Cherokee southbound on Garfield Ave. Trujillo failed to yield from the stop sign, entered the intersection and struck Iverson. Trujillo did not stop after the accident and was later found by officers on foot two miles from the accident location.

Iverson reported minor injuries and declined further medical attention.

The Ford sustained approximately \$10,000 in damage. The Jeep sustained approximately \$4,000 in damage.

Trujillo was arrested for operating a motor vehicle without a valid driver's license, driving with a suspended driver's license, failure to yield from a stop sign and leaving the scene of a personal injury accident.

The Sheriff's Office was assisted by the Sioux Center Police Department and Rock Valley Police Department.
