On Tuesday, September 18, at 10:38 a.m., the Sioux County Sheriff's Office investigated a motor vehicle accident that occurred on Marsh Avenue, one mile south of Granville, IA.

Kimberly Snyder, age 43, of Alton, IA was driving a 2009 Ford Econoline Van pulling a cargo trailer southbound on Marsh Avenue when she drove over a large amount of mud on the roadway caused by farm equipment entering the road, lost control of the vehicle, entered the east ditch and rolled.

Snyder and a passenger in the vehicle were both transported by the Granville Ambulance to the Orange City Hospital for treatment of minor injuries.

The van and trailer sustained approximately \$8,000 in damage.

The Sheriff's Office was assisted by the Granville Ambulance and the Granville Fire Department. The Granville Fire Department, Alton Fire Department, Hospers Fire Department and Sioux County Highway Department assisted with removal of the mud from the roadway.
